EASTERN HIMALAYA TOUR



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Day 01 : Arrive Guwahati

Arrive Guwahati Airport. Upon arrival, meet & assist by our company representative and transfer to the hotel for check-in. Guwahati is situated on the Southern bank of the mighty River Brahmaputra. Previously it was known as Pragjyotishpur (The City of the eastern Light) Guwahati is the fast growing premier city and it is also the gateway to the North Eastern states of India. This city subsequently got the name Guwahati (Guwa- means beetlenut and Hat – means market in Assamese) Overnight at Guwahati hotel.

Day 02 : Guwahati – Nameri National Park

Post breakfast; check-out from the hotel and drive to Nameri National Park- one of the two national parks in Assam is known for Mammals like Elephant, Tiger, Leopard and over 300 species of birds. The river Jia-Bhoro and its tributaries crisscross the park. Upon arrival; check-in to the Eco camp and rest of the time free at leisure. Overnight at Eco Camp.

Day 03 : Nameri National Park

Early morning go for the nature walk and the bird watching trip into the dense jungle of Nameri National Park with the forest guards. Afternoon you can opt for Mild River Rafting in Jia Bharali river adjoining to the Nameri National Park. Overnight at Eco Camp

Day 04 : Nameri – Bomdila

Morning after an early breakfast departs for Bomdila. En-route visit to Bhalukpong- a picturesque town. Visit an Orchidarium where you can see some of the rare and endangered species. Later drive to Bomdila. Upon arrival in Bomdila, check-in to the hotel. Bomdila; a picturesque town in the foothills of Himalayas. One can see the brilliant landscape and snow-clad Gorichen ranges of the Himalaya on a clear day. The town is famous for Bomdila Monastery, built under the guidance of Dalai Lama. Also visit craft center, where very fine wooden carpets of colorful designs and facades are produced. Overnight at Bomdila hotel.

Day 05 : Bomdila – Tawang

Post breakfast; drive to Tawang. En-route visit to Jaswant Garh; a war memorial for slain soldier Jaswant Singh Rawat. In spite of his death he is being awarded promotions as if he still alive.

Drive past Sella Pass; the entry point into the Tawang Valley. It is at an elevation of 13700 ft above the sea level. The glimpse of Paradise Lake in the Sella Pass makes your visit worth. Most of the time, the lake is covered with thick blanket of snow. Upon arrival at Tawang, check-in to the hotel and evening free at leisure. Overnight at Tawang hotel

Day 06 : Tawang

Post breakfast proceed for a tour in Tawang visiting; Tawang Monastery (Vihara); about 400 years old and the second largest Buddhist monastery in India. Also visit Urgelling Monastery; the birthplace of the 6th Dalai Lama who is the only Indian to have risen to such a high position in Gelupka Sect of Buddhism so far. Also visit Sangestser Lake; also known as Madhuri Lake is located 35 kms away from Tawang near the China Border.. Overnight at Tawang hotel

Day 07 : Tawang – Dirang

Post breakfast; drive to Dirang. En route visit to Nuranang falls. Upon arrival; check-in to the hotel. Dirang; is an ideal hill resort in West Kameng district with beautiful Apple Nursery, Kiwi Farm, Yak Research Centre, Buddhist Gumpa, Hot Water Spring and ancient Dirang Jong (Fort). It is the base camp for trekking to Gorichen peak and other bird watching trails.

Afternoon; visit to natural hot spring, Apple gardens and the Yak Breeding farms.

Overnight at Dirang hotel

Day 08 : Dirang - Bhalukpong

Post breakfast; drive back to Bhalukpong. Upon arrival; check-in to the Tourist Lodge. Rest of the day free at leisure for own activities. Overnight at Tourist Lodge

Day 09 : Bhalukpong – Kaziranga National Park

Morning after breakfast; depart for Kaziranga National Park. Kaziranga National Park; home of Horn Rhinoceros Upon arrival at Kaziranga; check-in to the hotel and rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight at Kaziranga Resort.

Day 10 : Kaziranga National Park

Early morning enjoy the elephant safari in the central (Kohora) range of Kaziranga. Later return to the resort for breakfast. Afternoon enjoy the ethnic cuisine in the Natundenga Karbi village adjoining Kaziranga National Park. Late in the afternoon enjoy the exclusive Jeep safari in the western (Bagori) range of Kaziranga. Overnight at Kaziranga Resort

Day 11 : Kaziranga – Shillong

Post breakfast; drive to Shillong, also known as The Scotland of East. En-route visit to Barapani (Umiyam Lake); It is a hub for the water sports activities such as speed boats, sailboats and water scooters. Adjoining to the lake, the Nehru Park offers an aviary and a collection of orchids and butterflies. Upon arrival at Shillong, check-in to the hotel. Shillong is one of the major tourist destinations in North East India. The British loved this place so much that they had established its Capital for Eastern Bengal and Assam. For its climate and unique topographical features the British referred Shillong as the "Scotland of The East". Overnight at Shillong hotel

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Day 12 : Shillong – excursion to

Cherrapunjee

Post breakfast; proceed for a full day excursion to Cherrapunjee. Cherrapunjee; locally known as 'SOHRA' Cherrapunji offers a panoramic view of the hilly terrains, deep gorges and valleys with its spectacular waterfalls. It was once having the record of being the wettest place on earth, with an average rainfall of about 1150ms. Here in Cherrapunjee, we will visit Nohkalikai falls; known to be the fourth longest fall in the world. Also visit Mawsmai Cave; 250m long cave is the major attraction for the tourists in Cherrapunjee. Evening return back to Shillong, en-route visit Elephanta falls and Shillong peak for some breathtaking views. Overnight at Shillong hotel

Day 13 : Shillong

Post breakfast; proceed for a tour in Shillong visiting Shillong Peak; it is the highest point of Shillong, located in the upper Shillong an altitude of 1961 meters (6,433 feet). Later visit to Elephant Falls; one of the majestic waterfalls in Meghalaya. The water of these three steps falls comes down in flows from different levels over the fern-covered rocks and falls into the canyon down below. Also visit to Wards Lake and Cathedral of Mary Help of Christian. Overnight at Shillong hotel

Day 14 : Shillong - Guwahati

Post breakfast drive back to Guwahati. Upon arrival; check-in to the hotel and later proceed for a guided tour visiting Kamakhya Temple; an ancient seat of Tantric and shakti Cults of Hinduism. Later visit to Shankardev Kalakshetra; a place where Assamese history and culture is depicted in a sprawling open enclosure. Rest of the day free at leisure for own activities. Overnight at Guwahati hotel.

Day 15 : Guwahati – Departure

Post breakfast; check-out from the hotel and transfer to Guwahati airport to board the flight to onward journey.

NORTH EAST HIMALAYAS TREKKING TOUR



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Day 01 : Guwahati -Tezpur

Our tour manager will welcome you at Guwahati airport. Later transfer to Tezpur and overnight at hotel.

Day 02 : Tezpur - Bomdila

Transfer to Bomdila. Bomdila; a picturesque town in the foothills of Himalayas. One can see the brilliant landscape and snow-clad Gorichen ranges of the Himalaya on a clear day. The town is famous for Bomdila Monastery, built under the guidance of Dalai Lama. Also visit craft center, where very fine wooden carpets of colorful designs and facades are produced. Overnight at Hotel Sipiangphong or similar.

Day 03 : Bomdila - Thembang

After a short drive to the trekking point we trek to Rahung village to see the Rahungpa tribe. After lunch trek upward to Thembang, one of the oldest Monpa tribal villages. Overnight in Camps at Thembang.

Day 04 : Thembang - Semnak

Trek to Semnak village. Overnight in Camps at Semnak

Day 05 : Semnak - Lagam

Trek to Lagam. Overnight in Camps.

Day 06 : Lagam - Chander

Trek to Chander. From Chander Village one can have beautiful views of the Himalayan peaks all around. Overnight in camps.

Day 07 : Chander - Shangti

Later a short drive to Dirang: Trek to Shangti. Then take a short drive to Dirang. Overnight at Hotel Pemaling.

Day 08 : Dirang - Tawang

After breakfast transfer to Tawang. Tawang is a major center of the Mahayana Buddhism. Overnight at hotel Buddha/Samdrupling or similar.

Day 09 : Tawang

Proceed for a tour in Tawang visiting; Tawang Monastery (Vihara); about 400 years old and the second largest Buddhist monastery in India. Also visit Urqelling Monastery; the birthplace of the 6th Dalai Lama who is the only Indian to have risen to such a high position in Gelupka Sect of Buddhism so far.

Day 10 : Tawang - Bomdila

After breakfast transfer to Bomdila. a picturesque town in the foothills of Himalayas. One can see the brilliant landscape and snow-clad Gorichen ranges of the Himalaya on a clear day. The town is famous for Bomdila Monastery, built under the guidance of Dalai Lama. Also visit craft center, where very fine wooden carpets of colorful designs and facades are produced. Overnight at hotel Sipiangphong or similar.

Day 11 : Bomdila - Nameri National Park

After breakfast transfer to Nameri National Park - one of the two national parks in Assam is known for Mammals like Elephant, Tiger, Leopard and over 300 species of birds. The river Jia- Bhoroli and its tributaries crisscross the park. Overnight at Eco-Camp, a camp resort located near the sparkling Jia Bhoroli river which forms a boundary to the park

Day 12 : Nameri – Guwahati Airport

After breakfast transfer to Guwahati airport for your departure flight. The tour ends here.

NAGALAND & MANIPUR TOUR





Day 01 : Dibrugarh - Sivasagar

Welcome on arrival in Dibrugarh Airport / Railway station. Transfer to Sivasagar. Overnight stay in Hotel.

Day 02 : Sivasagar - Mon

Morning drive to Mon. Evening free at leisure. Overnight stay in Hotel. Overnight at Varanadi hotel

Day 03 : Mon – Longwa - Mon

Morning visit Longwa village bordering Myanmar with the Angh's (chief) house partly in India and partly in Myanmar. Explore the village as you meet the local people. The original headhunting Konyak tribe used to tattoo their faces or their body as a mark of achieving a certain headhunting goal. As the practice is no more, people with tattoos on their face are the older men who had been successful in headhunting during their time. The Morung pillars have massive wood carving with motifs of tiger, elephant, hornbill, human beings etc. Later visit Shangkhachingnyu village as you meet the local gunsmith and step in the Angh's house see the animal head trophies on the wall. Overnight in hotel in Mon

Day 04 : Mon

After breakfast drive to Shangnyu village 28km 2hrs, here you will see the wooden monument measuring 8feet in height and 13feet in breadth – believed to be constructed by the heavenly angles. Human being and other creatures are carved on this monument. One can also see the memorial stone erected in front of the Angh's house. Post lunch visit Chui village bear a witness of the true Konyak Naga traditional house where the main pillar of the house jutting out of the roof. Overnight in hotel.

Day 05 : Mon – Sivasagar - Jorhat

Today you experience a total shift from the hill to the plain as you drive to Sivasagar once the Capital city of the Ahom Kingdom. Proceed to Jorhat. Overnight in Hotel.

Day 06 : Jorhat - Mokukchong

With packed lunch drive to Mokukchung- the headquarter of the Ao Nagas. They are known for their colorful attires and are regarded of having the most motifs shawl among the Nagas, which usually speaks the person's status in the community. En route get introduced to a Rengma Naga village TSEMINYU one can also collect their souvenir as we will see fantastic local weavers in this village. Picnic lunch. Drive to Longkhum village (Ao village) which was known as the vanguard of the Ao region during the spear and dao era. As the village is situated at 1586 mt. above sea level we can see some part of Himalaya on a clear winter morning. Depending on the time of arrival, explore Mopunchket village bamboo forest. Overnight in Hotel.

Day 07 : Mokukchong- Tuophema

Morning drive to Tuophema Village Resort run by the local Angami tribe. Explore the region and overnight in resort.

Day 08 : Tuophema - Kohima

Morning drive to Kohima, Nagaland's capital city. Visit Bara Basti village the 2nd largest village in Asia. Next visit the State Museum where one will come across a good representation of Naga attires and way of life, Kohima War cemetery and Church. Overnight in hotel.

Day 09 : Kohima - Khonoma - Kohima

After breakfast take a tour of the green village visiting the Morungs, meeting the local craftsmen. Visit the age group house & the ceremonial gates. Collectively Khonoma was known for its fighting prowess in the past and for the fallow management of its alder trees which balance the nature and its surrounding areas. Enjoy picnic lunch. Afternoon indigenous games will be displayed. Overnight in hotel

Day 10 : Kohima - Jakhama Village - Kohima

After breakfast, visit to Jetavana's monastery; Jetavana is said to once host Lord Buddha & his pilgrims, where one of his followers, a rich merchant, covered the whole ground of the park (Vana) with gold coins. Later we visit to Sri Lankan monastery. Afternoon, drive to Lucknow. Upon arrival, check-in to the hotel. Overnight at Lucknow hotel

Day 11 : Kohima - Imphal

Morning drive to Imphal, Manipur's capital city. Overnight in Imphal hotel.

Day 12 : Imphal

Today we take you for a cultural tour of the city covering monuments, temples and ceremonial places highlighting Imphal's rich past. Visit the Govindajee Temple, largest Krishna temple, the Khwairamband Bazaar the uniqueness of this market is that all the shops are owned and operated by women. and the War Cemeteries- Imphal has been major battle ground for British and Japanese forces during World War – II. Overnight in Imphal.

Day 13 : Imphal - National Park

Visit the Keibul Lamjao National Park (the only floating park in the world). It is the last natural habitat of the marsh dwelling brow-antlered deer locally called 'Sangai'. Drive to Moirang (45 km), the ancient capital of the Manipuri Kings. It is also the center of Meitei culture. Visit Loktak and Sendra lake Loktak Lake is the largest freshwater lake in the North East. Watch the unique floating islands 'Phumdi' that are actually floating weeds on which people live! Overnight in Imphal.

Day 14 : Imphal - Departure

In time transfer to Imphal Airport for onward journey

Day 01 : Arrival Guwahati – Shillong

You will be received at Guwahati and after a welcome ceremony transferred to Shillong. Have Lunch enroute at Borapani Umiam Lake, a majestic placid lake with its surrounding sylvan hills. Check in at your hotel. Overnight at your hotel in Shillong.

Day 02 : Shilong - Cherrapunjee

After an Early morning breakfast drive down to Krem Mawmluh Cave. This cave is located half a km west of Cherrapunjee adjacent to the small hamlet of Mawmluh. The cave has five river passage with impressive proportions. The cave has a length of over seven Kms. Explore the cave. Also visit the Waterfalls of Cherrapunjee (fourth tallest waterfall-Nohkalikai is at Cherrapunjee) & Living root Bridges. Overnight stay in Cherrapunjee.

Day 03 : Cherrapunjee

An early wake up call and breakfast in the morning and ready to walk to the Double Decker Living Root Bridge. An engineering marvel of Indigenous Khasi Tribesmen. Who weaved the routes of the eureka tree to make bridges across stream's. Evening at leisure to experience the breathtaking views of the Khasi hills and the plains of Bangladesh. Overnight at Cherrapunjee.

Day 04 : Cherrapunjee - Shillong

After breakfast drive to Shillong, the 'Scotland of the East'. En-route encounter Elephant Falls and Shillong Peak for some breathtaking views. Overnight at Shillong.

Day 05 : Shillong

Sightseeing at Shillong, admire the beauty of Shillong also called Scotland of the East. It is erstwhile capital of undivided Assam; present North-East and home to the Khasi Highland tribes. Overnight at Shillong

Day 06 : Shillong - Kaziranga

After a leisurely breakfast drive onto famous Kaziranga National Park. Overnight at Kaziranga National Park.

Day 07 : Kaziranga

Early morning, drive to Gaurikund. From Gaurikund, start your trek upto Kedarnath Temple. Alternatively, you can take helicopter ride to reach the Temple. Upon arrival, check-in to the hotel. And evening free for Pooja and Darshan. Overnight at Kedarnath hotel

Day 09 : Kedarnath – Gaurikund

,Gaurikund – Pipalkoti

Early morning after morning aarti, return back to Gaurikund. Further drive to Pipalkoti and check-in to the hotel.

Overnight at Pipalkoti hotel.

Day 10 : Pipalkoti – Badrinath

After breakfast, drive to Badrinath. Upon arrival, check-in to the hotel. Evening visit to Manna Village the last village of India before Tibetan Border. Later join the evening aarti ceremony in the Badrinath Temple.

Overnight at Badrinath hotel.

Day 11 : Badrinath – Srinagar

After early morning aarti, drive back to Srinagar. On the way visit Karanprayag; confluence of River Pindar & River Alaknanda. Upon arrival, in Srinagar, check-in to the hotel. Overnight at Srinagar hotel.

Day 11 : Badrinath – Srinagar

After early morning aarti, drive back to Srinagar. On the way visit Karanprayag; confluence of River Pindar & River Alaknanda. Upon arrival, in Srinagar, check-in to the hotel. Overnight at Srinagar hotel.

Day 02 : Puri – Half day tour

Post breakfast leave for full day tour in Puri visiting Jagannath Temple, Gundicha Temple & Narendra Tank. Rest of the day at leisure and relax at beach. Overnight at Puri hotel

Day 03 : Puri – Excursion to Konark

Post breakfast; leave for full day excursion to Konark to visit the Sun Temple. Also visit to fishermen's village. Evening; return back to Puri. Later day free to visit the beach market. Overnight at Puri hotel

Day 04 : Puri – Chilika – Gopalpur

Post breakfast; drive to Chilika Lake at Barkul en-route visit Raghurajpur craft village. On arrival at Barkul take the boat cruise to explore the bird's island and later proceed to Gopalpur. Upon arrival; check-in to the hotel. Overnight at Gopalpur hotel

Day 05 : Gopalpur – Rayagada

Post breakfast; drive to Rayagada. En-route visit Taptapani the hot sulphuric spring & Saura tribal villages. Upon arrival at Rayagada, check-in to the hotel. Overnight at Rayagada hotel.

Day 06 : Rayagada – excursion to Bisamkatak

Post breakfast; drive to Bisamkatak to visit weekly market of Desia kondh at Dukum (Weekly Market commence only on Tuesday). Later visit traditional craftsman village. Afternoon; drive to Niyamgiri hills to visit the original Dongaria kondh hamlets on special permit. Dongarias were once infamous for human sacrifice Overnight at Rayagada hotel.

Day 07 : Rayagada – Chatikona – Jeypore

Post breakfast; drive down to Chatikona to watch the interesting colorful weekly market of Dongriya Kondh Tribes (weekly market commences on Wednesday only). This tribe is one of most primitive tribe of the Kondh's they live in the high slopes of the Niyamagiri Hills. Later drive to Jeypore via Rayagada. Overnight at Jeypore hotel

Day 08 : Jeypore – Excursion to Onkudelli

Post breakfast; leave for an excursion to Onkudelli to visit the most interesting market of Bondos/Gadabas/Didayees (weekly market commence on Thursday only). Evening visit Ollar Gadaba tribal villages & later return back to your hotel. Overnight at Jeypore hotel

Day 09 : Jeypore – Kunduli – Gopalpur

After breakfast, drive to Kunduli to visit the weekly market of Paraja tribes (weekly market commence on Friday only). It is the biggest market of the tribal area. Later drive to Gopalpur. Overnight at Gopalpur hotel

Day 10 : Gopalpur – Bhubaneswar

Post breakfast; drive to Bhubaneswar en-route visit Khandagiri & Udaigiri Jain caves. Upon arrival Bhubaneswar, check-in to the hotel. Overnight at Bhubaneswar hotel.

Day 11 : Bhubaneswar Tour – Departure

Post breakfast; proceed for a guided tour in Bhubaneswar visiting the famous city temples including Rajarani, Parsurameswar, Mukteswar & Brahmeswar. Later on time; transfer to Bhubaneswar Airport to board the flight to onward journey.
