



Post breakfast. Drive to Delhi and on time transfer to Delhi airport to board the flight to onward journey.

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

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A combination of India and Nepal. it covers the important places in north India and Nepal. The program starts with the Delhi, the capital on India and the next stop is the famous pink city – Jaipur famous for its palaces and forts. This journey takes you through the monuments of Love Taj Mahal and erotic temples of Khajuraho. After visiting the city of spirituality – Varanasi the program continues into Nepal.

Day 1 : Delhi Arrival

Upon arrival at Delhi international airport, our company representative will meet & assist you with traditional welcome and transfer to your hotel for check-in. Rest of the day free & easy for own activities and acclimatization with Indian weather conditions. Overnight at Delhi hotel.

Day 02 : Delhi – Full day tour

Proceed for a full day guided tour in Delhi starting with Old Delhi visiting Raj Ghat - the memorial of Father of Nation Mahatma Gandhi, Jama Masjid - the biggest mosque in India. Enjoy rickshaw ride at Chandini chowk. Later drive past through Red Fort – A red sand stone fort by Mughal emperor Shahjahan. Afternoon continue the tour of Delhi visiting the New Delhi; Start the tour with a stop at India Gate – a war memorial built in the memory of thousands of British India army killed during First World. Continue the tour driving past Presidents house and Parliament house. Visit to Humayun's Tomb - a UNESCO World Heritage site, and Qutub Minar a 73 meter tall tower built in the year 1192AD. Overnight at Delhi hotel.

Day 03 : Delhi – Jaipur

(256 kms. / 05 hours drive)

Post breakfast; check-out from the hotel and drive to Jaipur; the capital city of Rajasthan State and also known as the "Pink City". Upon arrival Jaipur; check-in to the hotel and rest of the day free & easy for own activities.

Optional: Optional tour can be arranged for Samode Village Excursion or Chokhi Dhani Village Excursion. Overnight at Jaipur hotel.

Day 04 : Jaipur – Full day tour

Leave for an excursion to Amber Fort – a huge fort complex located on a hilltop. Enjoy the Elephant ride to ascend the Amber fort. The fort consists of Diwan - e – Aam , Diwan – e – Khas, Sheesh Mahal and Suck Niwas. After visiting Amber fort, visit to a traditional Rajasthani Handicraft & handloom factory to see the craftsmen performing. Afternoon; visit to City Palace – the royal palace for the Maharaja of Jaipur. The palace houses a great museum and Jantar Mantar – a astronomical observatory built in 1734 AD. It has the world's largest Sundial. Before returning your hotel; a short stop in front Hawa Mahal (Wind Palace) for photo shoot. Overnight at Jaipur hotel.

Day 05 : Jaipur – Agra via Fathehpur Sikri (240 kms. / 05 hours drive)

Post breakfast; check-out from the hotel and drive to Agra; the city of Taj Mahal. On the way stop at Fatehpur Sikri to visit Buland Darwaza, Diwan-e-aam and Diwanee-Khas. Further continue to Agra. Upon arrival in Agra; check-in to the hotel and later Proceed for the city tour of Agra. Visit the one of the seven wonders of world, The famous Taj Mahal.... The grace of perfection of proportions and grandeur of geometrical patterns of well-appointed gardens enhancing the poise of the whole complex together add magnificence to the delicacy of this adorable monument of love, dedication and purity, 'The Taj'! Continue to visit another UNESCO heritage monument, the famous Agra fort. This powerful fortress of red sandstone encompasses, within its 2.5-km-long enclosure walls, the imperial city of the Mughal rulers. It is one of the most important and robustly built strongholds of the Mughals, embellished with number of richly decorated buildings encompassing the imposing Mughal style of art and architecture. Overnight at Agra hotel.

Day 06 : Agra – Jhansi (By Shatabdi Train at 0811/1045 hrs) Jhansi – Khajuraho via Orchha

(165 kms. / 04 hours drive)

Post breakfast; check-out from the hotel and transfer to Agra railway station to board the train to Jhansi. Once reaching Jhansi; meet & assist by our company driver and drive to Khajuraho. En-route visit to Orchha; the historical town. Here you will visit Jahangir Mahal, Raj Mahal, Ram –Raja Mandir and laxmi Narayan Temple. Further continue your drive to Khajuraho. Upon arrival; check-in to the hotel and evening enjoy the sound & light show. Overnight at Khajuraho hotel

Day 07 : Khajuraho – Varanasi (By Flight)

Post breakfast; proceed for a guided tour to visit Khajuraho Group of Temples famous of its erotic art. Afternoon; transfer Khajuraho airport to board the flight to Varanasi, the oldest city in India. Upon arrival in Varanasi, transfer to the hotel for check-in and evening free at leisure for won activities and explore the oldest living city of India. Overnight at Varanasi hotel.

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Day 08 : Varanasi – Full day tour

Early in the morning before breakfast; enjoy the boat ride on Holy River Ganges at sunrise. Later return back to the hotel to have your breakfast. Further leave for an excursion to Sarnath; where Gautama Buddha first taught the Dharma, and where the Buddhist Sangha came into existence through the enlightenment of Kondanna. Afternoon return back to Varanasi and visit various ancient Temples in the city. Evening; witness the Aarti ceremony (lighting lamps) at holy river Ganges bank. Overnight at Varanasi hotel.

Day 09 : Varanasi – Kathmandu (By Flight)

Post breakfast; transfer to Varanasi airport to board the flight to Kathmandu; protected as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Durbar Square is the religious and social heart of Kathmandu's old city and is a complex of palaces, temples, shrines, statues and courtyards built between the 12th and 18th centuries by the ancient kings of Nepal. The square is a queer assortment of the old and the new - elaborately carved architectural features and curving roofs. Upon arrival in Kathmandu; transfer to your hotel and check-in to the hotel. Rest of the day free at leisure. Overnight at Kathmandu hotel.

Day 10 : Kathmandu – Pokhra

(200 kms / 06 hours)

Post breakfast; drive to Pokhara; a remarkable place of natural beauty. Situated at an altitude of 827m from the sea level and 200 km west of Kathmandu valley, the city is known as a center of adventure. The enchanting city with a population of around 95,000 has several beautiful lakes and offers stunning panoramic views of Himalayan peaks. The serenity of lakes and the magnificence of the Himalayas rising behind them create an ambience of peace and magic. So today the city has not only become the starting point for most popular trekking and rafting destinations but also a place to relax and enjoy the beauty of nature. Evening; enjoy the boating on Phewa Lake. Overnight at Pokhara hotel.

Day 11 : Pokhra – Full day tour

Post breakfast; proceed for a guided tour in Pokhara visiting David's Fall; Locally known as Patale Chhango (Hell's Fall), Devi's fall (also known as Devin's or David's) is an awesome waterfall lying about 2 km south-west of Pokhara airport on the highway to Tansen.

Later visit to Gupteswar Gupha; a sacred cave, lies 2 km from Pokhara airport on the Siddhartha Highway leading southwest from the city. The entrance is right across from Devi's Fall and the cave is almost 3 km long. It has some big hall-size rooms and some passages where you have to crawl on all fours. Also visit Barahi Temple; the most important religious monument in Pokhara. Built almost in the middle of Phewa Lake, the two storied pagoda is dedicated to the boar manifestation of Ajima, the protectress deity representing the female force Shakti.

Further continue your visit to Bindbyabasini Temple; Bindhyabasini temple is the center of religious activity in the old bazaar. It is dedicated to goddess Bhagwati, yet another manifestation of Shakti. Overnight at Pokhra hotel.

Day 12 : Pokhra - Sarangkot, the panoramic hill Station in Pokhara.

From here, you can see a panoramic sweep of Himalayan peaks, from Dhaulagiri (8167m) in the west to the perfect pyramid that is Machhapuchhare (6997m) and the rounded peak of Annapurna II (7937m) in the east. Most people come here at dawn or dusk, when the sun picks out the peaks in brilliant colours. Evening sightseeing of Pashupatinath Temple.

Day 13: Morning sightseeing of and

Swayambhunath and departure for airport.

Swayambhunath; The golden spire of the 5th-century Swayambhu stupa is adorned with a colorful fluttering of prayer flags; it crowns a hill overlooking the Kathmandu Valley and offers fantastic views over the city of Kathmandu. Swayambhunath is one of the most recognizable symbols in Nepal and the painted eyes of Buddha watch all those who ascend the worn stone steps. It is a World Heritage Site and one of the holiest Buddhist sites in Nepal and is at the source of the Valley's mythical beginning. Drive to airport for departure flight. Upon arrival in Delhi; transfer to the hotel for check-in. Evening; free & easy for own activities and last minute shopping. Overnight at Delhi hotel.

Day 14 : Delhi – Departure

Post breakfast; day free for own activities. Later transfer to Delhi International airport to board the flight to onward journey.

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

BUDDHIST PILGRINAGE TOUR







Upon arrival at Delhi international airport, our company representative will meet & assist you with traditional welcome and transfer to your hotel for check-in. Rest of the day free & easy for own activities. Overnight at Delhi hotel.

Day 02 : Delhi – Varanasi (By Flight)

After breakfast, transfer to Delhi airport to board the flight to Varanasi; situated on the west bank of holy river Ganges. Upon arrival, check-in to the hotel and later in the afternoon, proceed for an excursion to Sarnath; where, after enlightenment, Lord Buddha gave his first sermon about the basic principles of Buddhism - Four Noble Truths, Eightfold Path & the Middle Way. Overnight at Varanadi hotel

Day 03 : Varanasi – Bodhgaya

(245 kms. / 06 hours drive)

Early in the morning proceed for a board ride on the holy river Ganges. Later return back to the hotel and have your breakfast. Later drive to Bodhgaya; the place of Buddha's supreme enlightenment and one of the most important place in the life of Gautam Buddha. Upon arrival, check-in to the hotel and rest of the day free at leisure.

Overnight at Bodhgaya hotel.

Day 04 : Bodhgaya

After breakfast, proceed for a sightseeing tour of Bodhgaya visiting Mahabodhi Temple an UNESCO World Heritage Site. You can see the Bodhi Tree under which Buddha got enlightenment. Several Buddhist temples and monasteries are built by people of countries such as Thailand, Sri Lanka etc.. These temples reflect the architectural styles of their respective countries. Overnight at Bodhgaya hotel.



Day 05 : Bodhgaya – Patna via Rajgir and Nalanda (210 kms. / 06 hours drive)

After breakfast, drive to Patna. En-route visit to Rajgir; an ancient town, once the capital of the powerful state of Magadha. Also visit Nalanda, founded in the 3rd century BC the oldest university. At its peak it attracted students from all over the world Further continue to Patna and upon arrival, check-in to the hotel.

Overnight at Patna hotel.

Day 06 : Patna – Kushinagar via Vaishali (285 kms. / 08 hours drive)

After breakfast, drive to Kushinagar. En-route visit Vaishali; a vibrant republican state established as a republic by 6th century BC, prior to birth of Gautama Buddha in 563, making it the world's 1st republic. Buddha delivered his last sermon at Vaishali & announced his Nirvana there. Further continue to Kushinagar and check-in to the hotel. Kushinagar also known as Kushavati; Lord Buddha is said to have attained 'Mahaparnirvana', the freedom from the endless cycle of birth & rebirth. Overnight at Kushinagar hotel

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Day 07 : Kushinagar – Lumbini

(165 kms. / 04 hours drive)

After breakfast, visit to Nirvana Stupa the reclining statue of Buddha, Nirvana Temple and Madhukar Shrine. Afternoon, drive to Lumbini (Nepal); the birth place of Gautama Buddha. Upon arrival, check-in to the hotel.

Overnight at Lumbini hotel.

Day 08 : Lumbini – Sravasri

(200 kms. / 05 hours drive)

After breakfast, visit Ashoka Pillar; the first epigraphic evidence relating to the life history of Buddha. Cross the Indo Nepal border and drive to Sravasti a town where Buddha spent good part of his life. One can see age old stupas, temples and monasteries associated with him. Upon arrival, check-in to the hotel. Overnight at Sravasti hotel.

Day 09 : Sravasti – Lucknow

(180 kms. / 05 hours drive)

After breakfast, visit to Jetavana's monastery; Jetavana is said to once host Lord Buddha & his pilgrims, where one of his followers, a rich merchant, covered the whole ground of the park (Vana) with gold coins. Later we visit to Sri Lankan monastery. Afternoon, drive to Lucknow. Upon arrival, check-in to the hotel. Overnight at Lucknow hotel



Day 10 : Lucknow – Delhi (By Train)

After breakfast, proceed for a sightseeing tour visiting Bara Imambara, Alambagh and Dilkusha Palace. Afternoon, board the train to Delhi. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel for check-in. Overnight at Delhi hotel.

Day 11 : Delhi – Departure

Today on time transfer to Delhi airport to board the flight to onward journey.

SPLENDOURS OF UTTARAKHAND







Nestled in the lap of the Himalayas, Uttarakhand is one of the most beautiful northern states of India that enthralls everyone with its spectacularly scenic landscapes. Charming hill stations juxtaposed against snowcapped peaks, quaint villages along winding mountain roads, serpentine rivers carving their way through the hills.



Day 1 : Arrive Delhi - On to Bhimtal / Nainital (330 Kms / Approx 9 Hour Drive)

Welcome to Delhi - the Grand Capital of India. On arrival at the airport / railway station in Delhi, begin your tour of. Proceed on a picturesque drive to the charming hill station of Nainital. On arrival, check into your hotel.

Overnight in Bhimtal / Nainital.

Day 2 : Bhimtal / Nainital

This morning enjoy an excursion to the lakes which includes Sat Tal- a group of seven lakes including the famous jade green Garud Lake, the larger Bhimtal and Naukuchiatal, where you will have the opportunity for boating and paddling on direct payment basis. The rest of the day is at leisure.Relax or take stroll to the local markets. Overnight in Bhimtal / Nainital.

Day 3 : Bhimtal / Nainital

Today, you will visit the Naina Devi Temple and Hanuman Garhi. Naina Devi temple is a must visit in Nainital especially for people who seek spirituality and wish to offer their prayers to Goddess Naina. This temple is greatly visited by local devotees during religious festivals. The rest of the day is at leisure to explore the beautiful hill station of Nainital on your own. You can also spend the rest of the day shopping at Mall road or Tibetan market which is famous for its unique candle collection in various shapes, wooden artifacts, ethnic clothing, tiny wooden boats to huge pieces of detailed art etc. Overnight in Bhimtal / Nainital.

Day 4 : On to Ranikhet

(80 Kms / Approx. 3 Hour Drive)

After breakfast drive through the forested pine and deodar covered slopes, pass through fast flowing mountain streams to the popular hill station of Ranikhet. Located in the Kumaon hills, Ranikhet is a cool, quiet and serene hill station. On arrival, check into your hotel.

This afternoon, explore Ranikhet, the temples and the wonderful sights in Ranikhet such as 9-hole golf course, a Government Fruit Garden and Research Station at Chaubatia and the fascinating temples in Dwarahat.

The rest of the evening is at leisure. Breathe the salubrious mountain air, listen the chirping of birds and watch the crimson sunrays kissing snow laden Himalayas or relax at resort! Overnight in Ranikhet

Day 5 : Ranikhet - Corbett (200 Kms / Approx. 5 Hour Drive)

This morning, your journey continues to the wild tropical jungles to Corbett. On arrival, check into your hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure. Enjoy a jeep safari to spot a variety of wildlife on your own arrangements. The main wildlife animals found in the Corbett National Park include the tiger, elephant, chital, sambar, nilgai, gharial, King Cobra, muntjac, wild boar, hedgehog, common musk shrew, flying fox, Indian Pangolin, and nearly 600 species of birds. This park is a natural habitat of the rare species of Tigers that are facing extinction. It is a heaven for bird watchers, wildlife enthusiasts, environmentalists and nature lovers. Note : Corbett National Park remains open throughout the year for the visitors from Jhirna zone but the best time to visit Corbett is from 15th November to 15th June. Overnight in Corbett

Day 6 : Corbett - Mussoorie

(287 Kms / Approx. 7 Hour Drive)

Embark on a drive to the picturesque town of Mussoorie, spread along a horseshoe shaped ridge overlooking the Doon Valley.

Popularly known as the Queen of Hills is a charming hill station. Commanding a wonderful view of extensive. Himalayan snow ranges to the northeast and glittering views of the Doon Valley to the South, the town presents a scenic atmosphere to the tourists. On arrival, you will check into your hotel.

The rest of the evening is at leisure for independent activities.

Overnight in Mussoorie

Day 7 : Mussoorie

Morning proceed for a half-day sightseeing tour of Mussoorie visiting the Kempty Falls and the Gun Hill Point. Kempty Falls is popular among the tourists who visit Mussoorie and this cascading waterfall has successfully lured tourists from the very beginning. Kempty Falls is located approximately 15kms from Mussoorie on the Chakrata road surrounded by high green mountains and is set at an altitude of 4500ft. Gun Hill is situated 400mts above The Mall and it is the second highest peak of Mussoorie The rest of day is at leisure. You can enjoy the cable car ride from the Mall road to the Gun Hill point on direct payment basis. Overnight in Mussoorie

Day 8 : Depart Mussoorie * On To Delhi (270 Kms / Approx. 7 Hour Drive)

Today, bid farewell to your 'Splendours of Uttarakhand' tour, as you are transferred to the airport / railway station in Delhi for your onward journey.
