

## How Easy Is It to Visit Sri Lanka?

Sri Lanka's effortless entry procedures, short flight times from India, and a wellconnected transport network make adding this island paradise to your Indian itinerary a breeze.

#### **Visa Process**

### **Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA)**

 Apply online for a 30-day tourist ETA in minutes; approval typically arrives within 24-48 hours.

#### Visa on Arrival

 If you're unable to pre-register, you can obtain the ETA at Bandaranaike International Airport (CMB) on landing—just present a passport valid for ≥6 months and your return ticket. (Except India).

#### **Extensions**

 Visas can be extended up to 6 months by applying at the Department of Immigration in Colombo.



PRIVATE CAR HIRE	Door-to-door transfers with an English- speaking driver	Flexible
EXPRESS BUS	Air-conditioned coaches to major towns (Kandy, Galle, Anuradhapura)	2–4 hours
LOCAL TUK-TUK	Three-wheeler rides for short city trips	10-30 minutes

- Private car hires offer the most flexibility for off-beat destinations.


