

Day 01 : Arrive Cochin airport

Arrive Cochin airport and our company representative will meet you and take you to the hotel and help in check-in formalities. Overnight at Cochin hotelOvernight at Delhi hotel.

Day 02 : Cochin – Munnar)

Morning after breakfast, we take you around the city of cochin for a half day guided tour where you will be shown some important places such as Jewish Synagogue one of the oldest in Asia constructed in year 1568. , Dutch Palace originally constructed by Portuguese and later by Dutch , ST. Francis Church, and Chinese Fishing Nets introduced by Chinese travelers in 14th century but still used in these parts of Kerala Afternoon; drive to Munnar, a pleasing journey riding through the picturesque hills jacketed in greenish tea and spice plantations. Day 06 : Madurai - Trichy

Morning after breakfast we drive to Trichy, check in to hotel and proceed for a half day sightseeing In the afternoon visiting Rock Fort Temple. The Rock Fort situated on the banks of the Kaveri river, Trichy's most famed land mark is an 84 metre high rock, and it's one of the oldest in the world aprox.3,800 million years. The attraction is not for fort itself but the temple at the summit. 344 steps hewn out of rock lead to the top where the inscriptions dating back to the 3rd century B.C. and also visiting Jammbukeswara temple, MariammanTemple, SriRagna Swami Temple etc. Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 07 : Trichy - Tanjore

After breakfast proceed to Tanjore where you can visit Bragatheeswara temple which has been the chief political literacy and religious center of South India.The famous world Heritage monument of the most famous land Marks of Tanjore is the Bragatheeswara Temple, built in at the beginning of the 12th century by the greatest Chola emperor Raja RajaChola, after a memorable sightseeing. Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 08 : Tanjore - Swamimalai - Darasuram -Thimmakkudy - Tanjore

Morning after breakfast proceed for a full day sightseeing covering Swamimalai, Darshan at Murugan temple and afterwards visit DarasuramAirasatheswara Temple and Thimmakudi. Evening return to hotel.Overnight at hotel.

Day 09 : Tanjore - Gangaikonda Cholapuram -Chidambaram - Pondichery

After breakfast proceed to Chidambaram, en-route visit Gangaikondacholapuram temple. Upon arrival at Chidambaram visit Nataraja temple, Thillaikaliamman temple and evening proceed to Pondichery. Upon arrival check in at Hotel. Overnight stay at hotel.

Upon arrival check-in to the hotel. Overnight at hotel.

Day 12 : Mahabalipuram - Sightseeing

Morning after breakfast proceed for local sightseeing in & around Mahabalipuram which are on World Heritage protected monuments list. The temples and monuments believed during the period of Pallava Kings famous for their architecture. The famous are five Ratha temples. Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 13 : Mahabalipuram – Tiruvannamalai

Morning after breakfast check- out from the hotel and proceed to Tiruvannamalai. Upon arrival check in at hotel and freshen up evening free for leisure. Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 14 : Tiruvannamalai - sightseeing

After breakfast we will take you for a local sightseeing covering visit to Arunachaleswar Temple, It's the main highlight of travelling to Tiruvannamalai. Morning after breakfast day at leisure, later we will pick up from Hotel and transfer you to Chennai Airport / Railway station.





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

Day 01 : Arrive Chennai

Arrive Chennai - the gateway to southern India, established in 1639 by the East India Company, is one of the oldest cities of the country. Upon arrival Chennai Airport meet our representative who will transfer you to hotel. Overnight at Chennai hotel

Day 02 : Chennai – Mahabalipuram via Kachipuram

After breakfast; proceed for a guided tour in Chennai visiting the famous land mark like Anna salai Marine beach, Gandhi Memorial, Kala Kshetra, Mylapore temple and kapaleshwaran. Afternoon drive to Mahabalipuram. En-route visit Kanchipuram; the ancient capital of the Pallavas famous as a city of 1000 Temples and still has 124 shrines. The first temple dedicated to Shiva was built in the 7th and 8th century and has paintings on the walls. Further continue to Mahalbalipuram and upon arrival, check-in to the hotel. Overnight at Mahabalipram hotel.

Day 03 : Mahabalipuram

After breakfast; proceed for a guided tour in Mahabalipuram visiting the Shore Temple, one of the oldest temples. Unique about this temple is the fact that it houses shrines for both Lord Shiva and Lord Vishnu. Also visit The Five Rathas. There are five monolithic temples, each created in a different style. Overnight at Mahabalipuram hotel.

Day 04 : Mahabalipuram – Tanjore

Today morning post breakfast proceeds for Tanjore/Thanjavur. Upon arrival check-in at the hotel, later sightseeing tour of Tanjore. Tanjore is known as the Rice Bowl of Tamil Nadu. Visit Brihadeeswara or the Big Temple of God, an example of the magnificent achievements of the Cholas in the field of temple architecture. Also visit The Palace near the temple. It is a vast building of masonry built partly by the Nayaks around 1550 AD and partly by the Marathas. Also visit Saraswathi Mahal, a library which has over 30,000 palm leaf and paper manuscripts in Indian and European languages. Overnight at Tanjour hotel

Day 05 : Tanjore – Madurai via Trichy

Morning after breakfast drive to Madurai en-route visit Trichy. Trichy is famous for Rock Fort Temple. The Rock Fort situated on the banks of the Kaveri river, Trichy's most famed land mark is an 84 m high rock, one of the oldest in the world aprox.3,800 million years. Later drive to Madurai and on arrival, check-in at the hotel. Overnight at Madurai hotel Day 06 : Madurai – Full Day Tour

Morning after breakfast; proceed for a local sightseeing tour of Madurai. The temple town of Madurai, situated on the banks of river Vaigai, is one of the most ancient cities in India with a history dating back to the pre-Christian times. It was the imperial capital of the Pandyan Empire in the 14th Century AD. Madurai was the seat of Tamil learning and the last of the Tamil Sangams (Academies) was held here nearly 2000 years ago. Places of tourist interest include the imposing Meenakshi Temple, ThirumalaiNayakar Mahal, Gandhi Museum, Vaigai Dam, Thirupparankundrum, Athisayam Theme Azhagar Park, Water Koil and the VandiyurMariammanTeppakulam. Overnight at Madurai hotel

Day 07 : Madurai – Thekkady

Today we drive to Thekkady/Periyar, on arrival check-in at hotel. Periyar set on an attractive lake side; it is South India's most popular Wildlife Sanctuary. Periyar is a place to cruise on the lake & gives an opportunity to see wildlife. It is home to tigers, leopards, elephants, bison, antelopes, sambhar, wild boar, monkey, a wide variety of birds. Evening leave for a wildlife viewing to the sanctuary on lake Perivar by boat cruise. There is no better way see the herds of elephants than one the cruising on the lake. Overnight boat at Thekkady/Periyar hotel

Day 08 : Thekkady – Alleppy

Today at sun rise we take a boat ride to view wildlife in the sanctuary on Lake Periyar. After two hours of wildlife viewing we get back to the hotel for breakfast. Later we drive to Alleppey. Upon arrival; board the houseboat, locally called Kettuvallam, cruise around beautiful backwaters of Kumarakom to Alleppey to observe & experience the daily life of the villagers along the backwaters. Overnight at Alleppey hotel

Day 09 : Alleppey – Cochin

isembark from the houseboat in the morning and drive to Cochin, a historic port city in Kerala shaped by Arab, Chinese, and European influences. Upon arrival, embark on a half-day guided tour visiting notable sites such as the Jewish Synagogue (established in 1568 and among Asia's oldest), the Dutch Palace (built by the Portuguese and later renovated by the Dutch), St. Francis Church (reflecting Cochin's colonial legacy), and the iconic Chinese Fishing Nets (introduced by Chinese travelers in the 14th century and still in use today). In the evening, immerse yourself in Kerala's cultural heritage by attending a Kathakali Dance Show, where male performers wear vibrant costumes and masks to narrate stories through expressive dance. You will spend the night at a hotel in Cochin.

Day 10 : Cochin – Departure

After breakfast, day free & easy for own activities and shopping. On time transfer to Cochin international airport to board the flight to onward journey.

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
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MUMBAI - GOA - BELGAUM - BADAMI - AIHOLE - HOSPET - HASSAN - COORG - MYSORE - BANGALORE

KARNATAKA HERITAGE TOUR





Day 1 : Arrive Mumbai

On arrival you will be met by our representative & transferred to hotel, where we will be holding the rooms on ready occupancy basis. After traditional welcome check in into hotel. Overnight to be spent at hotel.

Day 2 : Mumbai

In the morning, we have for you a half day tour of : Gateway of India – The stone archway designed by Wittett in the 16th century Gujarati style, Prince of Whales Museum &Elephanta Caves – 9 kms by sea. These 7th century rock – cut cave temples dedicated to Lord Shiva are situated a top a hill on the island. With everlasting memories of the day spend night at hotel.

Day 3 : Mumbai - Goa

Transfer to Airport for flight to Goa. On arrival transfer to hotel. Overnight at hotel.

Day 4 : Goa

Now, be ready to visit the city that is called the "Archaeologist's Delight". In the morning you will visit North Goa and South Goa in the afternoon. Overnight at hotel.

Day 5 : Goa

Today is your day, i. e. It's the day to relax. Where? At the beautiful, refreshing and health prone beaches of Goa. Overnight at hotel

Day 6 : Goa - Belgaum - Badami

Today after breakfast drive to Badami enroute visiting Belgaum - a total picture of contrasts. On one side is the old town area and modern on other, in the heart of Belgaum is the Fort. Inside it are most famous Kamala Basti, the Jain Temple & the Jama Masjid. The Kapaleeswarar Temple, the Ananthashayana. Overnight at hotel.

Day 7 : Badami

Rock-cut cave Temples, Gateways, Forts, Inscriptions, Sculptures that seem to come alive before your eyes. Badami has to be seen to be believed. Climb a flight of steps to reach the ancient caves – all hewn out of sandstone on the precipice of a hill. Also a must see are Bhutanatha temples that lend their names to the lake just beneath the cave temples. Take a dip in this green tranquil river. It is said to have the healing properties. Badami also has the eighteen inscriptions ranging from 06 th to 09 th century. Overnight at hotel.

Day 8 : Badami – Aihole – Pattadakal –

Hospet

Today is your lucky day as you are going to Hospetenroute visiting Aihole and Pattadakal, and for that nothing can be said as everything is self explanatory. Aihole which is famous as the "cradle of the Indian Architecture". You will also visit Pattadakal – Situated on the left bank of the Malaprabha river, a world heritage centre, has 10 major temples representing early Chalukyan architecture, later continue towards Hospet. Overnight at hotel.

Day 9 : Hospet



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

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
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
