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

TAJ WITH TIGERS TOUR









Day 01 : Delhi Arrival

Upon arrival at Delhi international airport, our company representative will meet & assist you with traditional welcome and transfer to your hotel for check-in. Rest of the day free & easy for own activities and acclimatization with Indian weather conditions. Overnight at Delhi hote

Day 02: Delhi – Full day tour

Proceed for a full day guided tour in Delhi starting with Old Delhi visiting Raj Ghat- the memorial of Father of Nation Mahatma Gandhi, Jama Masjid - the biggest mosque in India. Enjoy rickshaw ride at Chandini chowk. Later drive past through Red Fort – A red stone fort by Mughal emperor Shahjahan.

Afternoon continue the tour of Delhi visiting the New Delhi; Start the tour with a stop at India Gate – a war memorial built in the memory of thousands of British India army killed during First World. Continue the tour driving past Presidents house and Parliament house .Visit to Humayun's Tomb - a UNESCO World Heritage site, and Qutub Minar a 73 meter tall tower built in the year 1192AD.

Overnight at Delhi hotel.

Day 03: Delhi – Jaipur

Post breakfast; check-out from the hotel and drive to Jaipur; the capital city of Rajasthan State and also known as the "Pink City".

Upon arrival Jaipur; check-in to the hotel and rest of the day free & easy for own activities.

Optional: Optional tour can be arranged for Samode Village Excursion or Chokhi Dhani Village Excursion. Overnight at Jaipur hotel.

Day 04 : Jaipur – Full day tour

Leave for an excursion to Amber Fort – a huge fort complex located on a hilltop. Enjoy the Elephant ride to ascend the Amber fort. The fort consists of Diwan – e – Aam, Diwan – e – Khas, Sheesh Mahal and Suck Niwas. After visiting Amber fort, visit to a traditional Rajasthani Handicraft & handloom factory to see the craftsmen performing.

Afternoon; visit to City Palace – the royal palace for the Maharaja of Jaipur. The palace houses a great museum and Jantar Mantar – a astronomical observatory built in 1734 AD. It has the world's largest Sundial. Before returning your hotel; a short stop in front Hawa Mahal (Wind Palace) for photo shoot.

Overnight at Jaipur hotel.



Day 05 : Jaipur – Ranthambore National Park

Post breakfast, drive to Ranthambhore National Park. This is one the largest National Park in north India famous for its tiger reserve. As per the recent calculation, there are 24 Tigers in the national park.

Another attraction in Ranthambhore is "Ranthambhore Fort"; The fort lies within the Ranthambhore National Park which was formerly the hunting grounds for the Maharajahs of Jaipur before Indian independence.

Upon arrival Ranthambhore, check-in to the resort and rest of the day free at leisure.

Overnight at Ranthambhore Resort

Day 06 : Ranthambhore National Park – Jungle Safari

Day 01: Arrive Mumbai

Reception upon arrival and transfer to the hotel Mumbai formerly known as Bombay) is the capital city of the Indian state of Maharashtra. Mumbai is the financial, commercial and entertainment capital of India. It is also one of the world's top ten centres of commerce in terms of global financial flow, Overnight at the hotel.

Day 02: Mumbai

Morning excursion to Elephanta Caves. (a UNESCO World Heritage Site) and a collection of cave temples predominantly dedicated to the Buddhist god Gautam Buddha. They are located on Elephanta Island, 10 kilometers the east of the city of Mumbai (the trip to the island is by boat only). It consists of five Shaivite caves and a few Buddhist stupa mounds that may be dating to the 2nd century BCE, as well as a small group of two Buddhist caves with water tanks

Afternoon city tour of Mumbai visiting Gateway of India, the entrance to the port of Mumbai. We also drive through the Marine Drive, which runs along the shore of the Arabian Sea from Nariman Point past Chowpatty Beach to the foot of Malabar Hill. Also visit Dhobi Ghat (open air laundry)., Mani Bhavan (home of Mahatma Gandhi in Mumbai), and Hanging Gardens. Overnight at the hotel

Day 03: Mumbai-Nagpur-Pench

Breakfast at the hotel

In time transfer to Mumbai Airport for flight to Nagpur. Reception upon arrival and drive to Pench National park (2.5 hrs)

Pench national park derives its name from the Pench River that flows through the park from north to south dividing the park into almost equal western and eastern halves, It is one of premier tiger reserve in India and recorded highest number of Tigers . The fictional works of Rudyard Kipling, The Jungle Book and The Second Jungle Book, are set in the region. Kipling himself never visited the area, instead basing his descriptions on other locations in India.

Afternoon safari into the national park in an open Jeep, accompanied by an experience naturalist. It is the best way to observe wildlife at the thick forest

Dinner and Overnight at the hotel.

Day 04: Pench – Kanha

Early morning safari into the national park in an open Jeep, accompanied by an experience naturalist. It is the best way to observe wildlife at the thick forest.

Return to hotel and have breakfast.

Check out and drive Kanha (5 hrs) and upon arrival check in at the hotel Spread across 940 sq.km, Kanha National Park is one of the largest parks in Madhya Pradesh where the majestic royal Bengal tigers are found in good numbers. The Park is respected globally for saving the Barasingha from near extinction. No doubt, it is one of the best managed parks in Asia and a part of Project Tiger. National Geographic's award winning 'Land of the Tigers' was shot here, but the park is home to leopards, wild dogs and Barasingha as well. A safari in Kanha will surely get you thrilled, the way you were on your first trip to the zoo, as a child. Has a significant population of royal bengal tigers. Over 350 species of birds and flora are found in this national park. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day 06: Kanha - Bandavgarh

Early morning safari into the national park in an open Jeep, accompanied by an experience naturalist. It is the best way to observe wildlife at the thick forest. Return back to the hotel.

Breakfast at the hotel and check out.

Later drive to Bandavgarh National park (5 hrs)

Bandhavgarh the land of tigers. This is the place to visit if you want to spot the big cat. India's top dwelling for tigers, Bandhavgarh National Park has the highest density of Royal Bengal tigers in the world. The sight of the majestic tiger, up close and personal, is said to trigger a sense of awe in you, of the kinds you would have only experienced in your childhood.

Rest of the day free for own activities.

Dinner and Overnight at the hotel.

Day 07 : Bandavgarh

Khajuraho is one of the most popular tourist spots in Madhya Pradesh. It is famous for its ancient temples that depict some of the finest art in the world. These temples depict various forms like meditation, spiritual teachings, kinship, wrestling, royalty and most significantly, erotic art. Based on their geographical location, the temples are categorised into three groups: Eastern, Western and Southern. Beautiful, intricate and expressive, the sculptures of the Khajuraho temples will leave you in awe and wonder.

Most Khajuraho temples were built between 950 and 1050 by the Chandela dynasty. Historical records note that the Khajuraho temple site had 85 temples by the 12th century, spread over 20 square kilometers. Of these, only about 25 temples have survived, spread over six square kilometers. Of the surviving temples, the Kandariya Mahadeva Temple is decorated with a profusion of sculptures with intricate details, symbolism and expressiveness of ancient Indian art. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 10: Khajuraho – Agra

Breakfast at the hotel.

In time transfer to the Jhansi Railway station for train Agra (5 hrs) visiting enroute Orchha

The historic town of Orchha, nestled on the banks of river Betwa, was founded in the 16th century by the Bundela Rajput Chief, Rudra Pratap. The ancient town seems frozen in time, with its many monuments continuing to retain their original grandeur even to this day. Here you will find some of the most fascinating temples and palaces that will help you realise a childhood fantasy – travelling back in time!

Visit Ram Raj Temple , Chaturbhuj Temple and other important monuments.

Post visit drive to Jhansi railway station to board train to Agra

Upon arrival transfer to the hotel and check.

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
Day 12: Delhi

The park today stretches in a series of gentle hills & valleys, north of the river Kabini. It has all the resident wildlife of the Nilgiri hills: NilgiriTahr, Nilgiri Langur, bison, leopard, Asian elephant, wild boar, deer, dhole (wild dog) & porcupine, besides tigers.

Evening; proceed for one more ride into the Park. Overnight at Nagarhole Resort

Day 05: Nagarhole National Park – BR Hills

After breakfast, drive to BR Hills; Biligirirangana range of hills are picturesquely situated between the Cauvery & Kapila rivers. The hill range from north to south for about 16 Kms. All round are deciduous trees. Upon arrival, check-in to the hotel and later day free at leisure to enjoy this beautiful paradise. Overnight at BR Hills Hotel/Resort

Today morning post breakfast, proceed to sightseeing at Munnar. Visit Eravikulam National Park at Rajamala famous for Nilgiri Thar, Echo Point, Tea Plantations and TATA Tea processing Factory, Anayirankal Dam, Lockhart Gap Point etc.

Overnight at Munnar hotel

Day 12: Munnar – Periyar

After breakfast; drive to Periyar (Thekkady), one of India's most fascinating natural wildlife sanctuaries. The vegetation, the flora & fauna & the birds are uniquely rich, vast & varied that it does not bear semblance to any other wildlife sanctuaries in the world. Upon arrival, check-in to the hotel.

Evening; enjoy the boat ride through the Periyar lake around which the wild-life sanctuary is situated, offers a soul stirring pleasant experience. Overnight at Thekkady hotel

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Day 13 : Periyar – Kumarakom

Early in the morning, take a boat ride to view wildlife in the sanctuary on Lake Periyar. After two hours of wildlife viewing, return back to the hotel and have your breakfast. Further; check-out from the hotel and drive down to Kumarakom; a cluster of little islands on the Vembanad Lake. Upon arrival, check-in to the hotel and later day free at leisure to enjoy the beautiful backwaters of Kerala. Overnight at Kumarakom Hotel/Resort

Day 14: Kumarakom – Alleppey

Early in the morning leave for a bird watching tour to the Kumarakom Bird sanctuary. The sanctuary is the home of Cormorants, Teals, Ducks, Darters (snake birds), Night Herons, Egrets, Siberian Storks, Golden Backed Woodpecker, Crow Pheasant, White-Breasted Water Hen and Tree Pie. Afternoon; board the houseboat locally knowKettuvallam; cruise around beautiful backwaters of Kerala to observe & experience the daily life of the villagers along the backwaters. Overnight at Houseboat

Day 15 : Alleppey – Cochin

Post breakfast; disembark houseboat at Alleppey and drive to Cochin. Upon arrival, check-in to the hotel.

Later we take you around the city of cochin for a half day guided tour where you will be shown some important places such as Jewish Synagogue one of the oldest in Asia constructed in year 1568., Dutch Palace originally constructed by Portuguese and later by Dutch, ST. Francis Church, and Chinese Fishing Nets introduced by Chinese travelers in 14th century but still used in these parts of Kerala.

In the evening attend the traditional "Kathakali Dance Show". One of the famous dance forms of India where male actors tell a story by wearing facemasks and colorful costumes.

Overnight at Cochin hotel.



Day 16: Cochin – Departure

Post breakfast; on time departure transfer to Cochin airport to board the flight to onward journey.
